

Adults who want to change job: a chance for agro-forestry

All around the world, young people, urban, immigrants, want to invest themselves in social and local economy. Jobs linked to agro-forestry (production + local transformation and trade) correspond to these expectations. They bring quality of employment, social purpose and involve diversified tasks.

Savoir-faire et découverte offers to train these people towards ecological and manual craftsmanship and skills linked to local organic agriculture and the agro-food. Supervisors are artisans and farmers. They teach and train using both theoretical and hands-on training in work situations.

These traineeships lead to project leaders becoming beekeeper, baker cooking with wood fire and natural leavened, cheese maker, vegetarian cook, cabinetmaker working local wood, brewer farmer, leather goods, manufacturer of cosmetics made from wild and cultivated plants, designer of clothing made from natural fibers and dyes.

They get their supplies of products from the agro-ecology and work within it. They partake in the renewal of a competitive local and ecological agro-sector.
